WELCOME TO WOODLAND BEACH!

Whether this is your first visit or you have been here many times before, we hope you will find the community welcoming and the beach beautiful. Woodland Beach is a special place and we all must do our part to keep it beautiful and clean. Thank you for your cooperation.

BONFIRES

- Before lighting a fire in your firepit, please check to ensure that fires are permitted at the time
- Fire pits must be attended at all times
- Fire pits should be clear of vegetation or overhanging trees
- Fire pits should not be placed over top of a septic leaching bed
- Keep water nearby to distinguish fires
- Permits are required for any fires and can be purchased at the Township of Tiny Office, located at 130 Balm Beach Road West

BEACH ETIQUETTE

- Stay off of sensitive areas, like beach dunes
- Be considerate of other visitors with respect to noise, waste and language
- Keep the cleaning products at the cottage- please do not wash dishes or your hair in the lake
- Respect wildlife, do not approach or feed
- Dispose of cigarette butts and waste in proper receptacles

COTTAGE ETIQUETTE

- This cottage is on a septic system. Please be careful of how much water you use so as to keep the system running smoothly and effectively. An overflowing septic system directly impacts the water quality of the beach
- Tiny Township has a 24 hour noise bylaw. Please keep your speakers indoors and be respectful of those around you, particularly in the evening and overnight hours
- Please review the Simcoe County Waste Management calendar for schedule and ensure garbage, compost and recycling is separated, sorted properly, put out on Monday am before 7am, and is secure from wild animals
- Fireworks are prohibited unless on Canada Day, Victoria Day, New Years Eve or New Year's Day, and the 5 days preceding or following these days
 - NOTE: fireworks are not permitted after 11pm
- ATVS and Sleds are not permitted on roads in Tiny Township with the exception of specific streets, listed in the Tiny Township ATV Road Pilot Project

DOGS

- Woodland Beach is dog-friendly and Fido is welcome to join you on the beach
- Please ensure your dog is leashed and under voice control at all times
- Please pick up any waste left by your pooch

NOTE TO PROPERTY OWNERS

Short Term Rental property owners are encouraged to be active hosts in ensuring that their guests enjoy an excellent stay at Woodland Beach and that their neighbours are not inconvenienced. Short Term Rental operators can be held accountable for the actions of their guests. If a Municipal By-law is broken, fines can be charged to the individuals who violated the regulation and inspection fees can be charged to the property owner.
